Lime Contracting raises "Canyon of Heroes" banner in salute of Gulf War Vets Lime Contracting provides exterior building restoration/preservation services

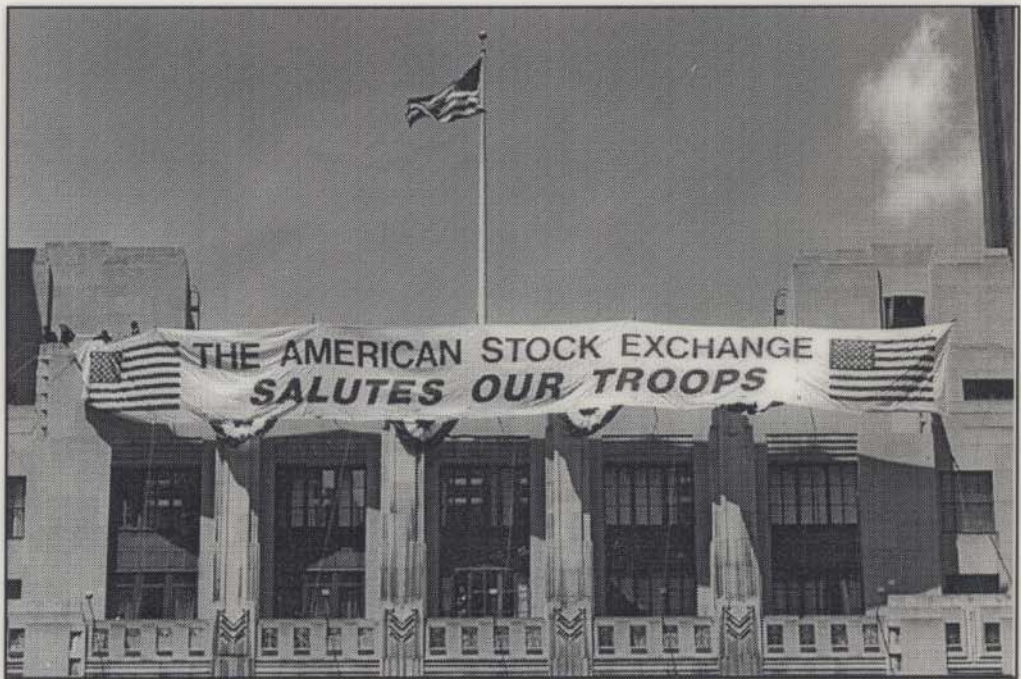

delphia has engaged the services of Lime for the complete demolition, restoration and installation of a waterproofing membrane of the exterior plaza deck area that was above the structure parking garage. O'Brien Kreitzberg served as the project engineer.

Other historic projects completed by Lime Contracting include the mounting of

an 82 ft. high King Kong on top of the Empire State Building, and the rigging of the lower Broadway's "Canyon of Heroes" banner in salute of the Gulf Ware Veterans (shown).
